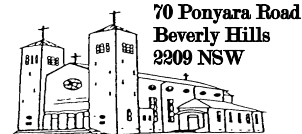

The Liturgy Office is presenting a program of formation and training for both new and presently-serving ministers conducted at three different venues on Thursday evenings and Saturdays in July through August. A certificate of mandate as an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion will be given to those completing the first four sessions, who will then be eligible for commission in their parishes by their parish priests. Why do we anoint people?

The practice of anointing with oil dates back to ancient times. In the Old Testament it was used in the consecration of priests and kings. The healing and fragrant properties of the oil made it an appropriate symbol of the strength of God and the sweetness of a virtuous life. The Christian Church adopted this ritual to indicate the imparting of the Holy Spirit. Today we anoint the sick and those in danger of death to invoke God's healing and comforting presence. We also anoint people in the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Orders as a sign of their consecration to Christ through the transforming power of the Spirit.
